COUNSELLORS CORNER

A recently-developed therapy is gaining evidence for its effectiveness in treating depression in adults and teens. Interpersonal Therapy (IPT) may be the right choice for some people. What's it about? It's based on the idea that people become depressed if key interpersonal relationships are not working well. By focusing on the problem area in therapy the client is helped to improve their relationships and so resolve their depression.

Students who have a special need that affects their performance in examinations can apply to the Board of Studies for Disability Provisions through their school. These provisions are categorised into learning difficulties, hearing impairment and vision impairment. If students have a condition such as ADD, ADHD or anxiety they are also entitled to medical provisions.
