Why students should attend:	Students will complete mandatory field work for the study of Population and Development Geography.

Return point and time:	Quakers Hill Station, 3.15pm
Students will be transported by:	Train and Ferry
Travel Details:	Students will meet at Quakers Hill Station. They will travel by train to Parramatta Station and then walk to Charles Street Wharf where they will catch the Rivercat to Circular Quay. Students will return by train from Central Station to Quakers Hill Station.
Transport Cost:	Venue Cost: No Cost. Transport Cost: Students are not allowed to use their School Opal for any travel which is not between school and home.
