Dear Parents/Carers and Students

Re: Year 10 2021 – Timeline of Events for the remainder of the year

The following information outlines a number of events that affect Year 10 during the remainder of this term.

Under the current legislation, all students must complete Year 10. Year 10 Students are expected to remain at school and participate in normal lessons until the end of the year in order to be eligible for the Stage 5 RoSA (Record of Student Achievement).

After Year 10, and until each student turns 17, they must be either in school, or registered for home schooling; or in approved education or training (eg. TAFE, traineeship, apprenticeship); or in full-time, paid employment (average 25 hours/week); or in a combination of work, education and/or training.

All secondary schools are also required to maintain documentation stating the destination of any student who is leaving their current school. Parents/carers of students who are not completing Year 11 in 2022 at St John Paul II Catholic College are asked to advise the school in writing, if you have not already done so.
