Year 12 2022 – Commemorative Jersey

Dear Parents/Carers and Students,

To help celebrate the final year for Year 12, 2022, orders for the St John Paul II Commemorative Jersey are now being taken. The creation and wearing of a Year 12 jersey is a tradition practised in many schools.

The wearing of the jersey is a privilege afforded to students who consistently meet the College standards of uniform and attendance. The CEDP attendance expectation is at least 90%. For the students who do meet the required standards, the jersey can only be worn as part of the uniform on Friday of each week in 2021/22. As part of placing an order, parents, carers and students are agreeing to the following:

- *I/we understand that wearing the jersey is a privilege afforded to students who have an attendance rate of 90+% and have consistently worn the College uniform correctly.*
- *I/we understand that the jersey can only be worn as part of the uniform on Friday of each week in 2021/22.*
- *I/we understand that all nicknames are to be approved by the Principal of the College.*

The jersey is polyester with long sleeves and features the school colours. The back of the jersey features the year (2022) and space for a name/nickname. Sizes range from 2XS to 4XL. Please note orders will only be placed with the company pending the approval of all names/nicknames by the Principal of the College.

The jersey cost is \$88. Payment **must** be paid in full when ordering. Orders and payment will be taken until Wednesday 3 November 2021. No orders can be accepted after this date. If the full amount has not been paid by 3 November 2021, the order will be invalid. Students are to submit the Google form with their size and name/nickname. This can be found on the Year 11 Google Classroom. Payments are to be made using the QKR App.

It is planned that students will take their jersey to Retreat and wear it for the traditional group photo.
